## LCEO preparing for winter storm to impact northwest Ohio

Road maintenance crews are gearing up for the upcoming winter storm expected to impact Lucas County Wednesday. Weather forecasts are calling for four to eight inches of snow to fall from early Wednesday morning into the evening.



Our garage is doing final inspections of all vehicles and equipment, topping off trucks with salt and deicers, putting down brine and reviewing all phase one and phase two snow routes for drivers.
